What is Faith Promise?

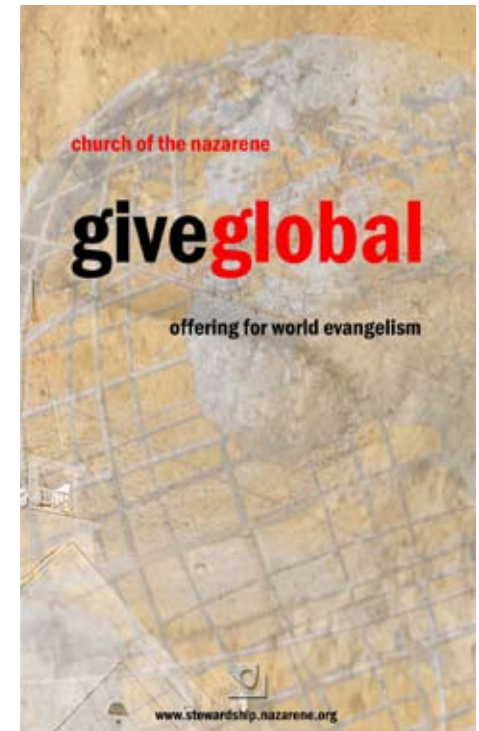
FAITH PROMISE is one of the most meaningful methods for supporting missions. It is not a pledge. A Faith Promise is exactly what it says — a promise made in faith between an individual and God. That promise is based on what the giver believes God wants him or her to give over and above their regular tithe to the local church.

Faith Promise is one avenue of supporting the World Evangelism Fund, which is the backbone of giving and stewardship in expanding the international Church of the Nazarene. World Evangelism Fund provides the foundation for mission giving around the world. Together, as we give to Faith Promise, we can achieve more by pooling our resources so we can reach further cooperatively and complete our mission to make Christ-like disciples in the nations.
