

# Auction Pay-Out Structure

Every Student needs to complete (4) shares in order to receive full amount of funds.

Shares include:

1. Turning in their (4) items at a \$250 value.
2. Parent or relative participation
3. Completing all (9) job points
4. Attending auction and helping with clean up and tear down.

We will then take the full amount raised, divide by shares completed by all students, and distribute that amount by how many shares each student completed.

**FOR EXAMPLE:** Let's say we raise \$10,000 and 20 kids complete all (4) shares. That would be 80 shares.

We would then divide  $\$10,000/80$  shares which would = **\$125/share**

**If a student completes all (4) shares, he/she would make \$500 in their account.**

**If a student completes only (2) shares, he/she would make \$250 in their account.**
